



**Job Title: Park Ranger**

The Roatan Marine Park's Park Ranger implement rules and regulations of the National Marine Park of the Bay Islands or activities involving patrolling and acts as liaison between the Roatan Marine Park and the community, Artisanal Fishing Association and Industrial fishermen, Co managers of the National Marine Park of Bay Islands, Roatan businesses and dive centers.

**Reports to:** Patrol Coordinator/Executive Director

**Areas of Responsibility:**

1. Undertake monthly boat maintenance as required
2. Daily management of boats
3. Implement the weekly patrol plan
4. Implement the daily patrolling software (SMART tools) and transfer the information to the Patrol Coordinator (training will be provided)
5. Participate in weekly coordination meeting with coordinator and/or RMP staff
6. Respond to reports of broken equipment and provide timely maintenance.
7. Implement the rules regulations of the Bay Islands National Marine Park.
8. Maintain relationships and lines of communication with the fisherman's association, water taxi association, and local business owners on behalf of the Roatan Marine Park.
9. Work with other Roatan Marine Park employees
10. Assist in the organization of Roatan Marine Park events when required (lionfish derby, lionfish cook-off, fundraisers, photo competition, etc).

**Qualifications Necessary:**

To effectively carry out the position of Park Ranger, one must exhibit the following qualifications:

1. He/she must have a positive attitude and be flexible to quickly changing situations and needs.
2. Must be outgoing, forthcoming and able to create new relationships and positively sustain existing relationships with Roatan Marine Park funders and stakeholders.
3. Fluency in written and spoken English; an advanced level of spoken and written Spanish would be desirable, fluency ideal.
4. Knowledge of diving preferred
5. Must be able to work 8 hours/day, available outside of normal hours to work at RMP events and respond to emergencies.
6. Have a valid boat operator credential

7. Completed high school as a minimum requirement.
8. At least 5 years of boat captain experience.
9. Must hold first aid, rescue, survival at sea, fire fighting basic courses preferred.
10. Must have a clear criminal and police record.
11. Current car or motorcycle driving license
